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#### **WURTTEMBERG'S WEALTH OF INNOVATION**

Senior Editor Stuart Pigott set off on a tasting trip to the German wine region of Wurttemberg, which he has long considered grossly underrated, and was pleased to find a wealth of winemaking ambition and innovation.

Another astonishing pinot noir was the Schnaitmann Spätburgunder Württemberg Lämmler GG 2021, which was extraordinarily elegant with a delicate sweetness at its heart. The super-fine tannins and extremely long finish of cooked red beets and earth set the crown on this pinot masterpiece. However, Stuart preferred another wine from the great Lammler site, the Schnaitmann Lemberger Württemberg Lämmler GG 2020, which he found to be a deep well of forest berries, baking spice, wet earth and vanilla.

## SCHNAITMANN LEMBERGER WÜRTTEMBERG LÄMMLER GG 2020 Württemberg

Score 96

The nose of this wine is a deep well of forest berries, the whole range of baking spices, wet earth and vanilla. Very concentrated, focused and elegant this medium- to full-bodied Lemberger is wonderfully fresh and vibrant with a compact finish that extends way out there. With aeration a violet aroma develops, adding to the wine's stunning complexity. From biodynamically grown grapes. Unfiltered. Drink or hold.

## SCHNAITMANN RIESLING WÜRTTEMBERG BEUTELSBACHER ALTENBERG EL 2022 Württemberg

The lime blossom aroma of this remarkable Wurttemberg dry riesling pulls you into this extremely elegant, medium- to full-bodied wine that has the kind of depth we expect from top Alsatian wines combined with a stunning mineral freshness that powers the super-long finish. Very limited production. From biodynamically grown grapes. Vegan. Drink or hold.

The spectacular smoky and flinty nose pulls you into this simultaneously compact and racy sauvignon blanc that has great concentration, textural richness and mineral energy. Very long, stony finish with wonderful energy. From biodynamically grown grapes. Vegan. Drink or hold.

Still youthful, but already extremely elegant and precise, with a delicate sweetness at its heart, this is a great German pinot noir that defies everything the weather threw at the grapes during this challenging growing season. Super-fine tannins. Fascinating long finish with notes of cooked red beets and wet earth. From biodynamically grown grapes. Unfiltered. Drink or hold.

This remarkable 2021 Lemberger has an enveloping nose of red fruits, summer flowers and green pepper. Still tightly wound and quite racy with stacks of mineral freshness on the medium-bodied palate. Made for the long term and only just starting to open up. From biodynamically grown grapes. Unfiltered. Drinkable now, but best from 2026.

Stacks of allspice and clove, also sour cherry and lemon peel. This youthful, medium-bodied Lemberger is very elegant with impressive concentration for the challenging vintage. Then the fine tannins build at the long structured finish in a way that reminds me a bit of cool climate syrah. Excellent aging potential. From biodynamically grown grapes. Unfiltered. Drink or hold.

Complex nose of flint, wild herbs and lime. Super-elegant with a wonderful interplay of flint, smoke and creaminess on the palate. The restrained acidity is easily enough to make this diamond-bright at the long, intensely stony finish. From biodynamically grown grapes. Vegan. Drink or hold.

The aromas of this stunning youthful pinot noir expand and expand as it aerates in the glass. A very wide spectrum of red fruits, fresh herb character and savory complexity are wrapped around the fine tannins on the medium-bodied palate. The acidity animates the very long and delicately earthy finish, which is dangerously energetic! From biodynamically grown grapes. Unfiltered. Drinkable now, but best from 2025.

A fragrant Lemberger with notes of violets and red fruits plus a delicate touch of baking spice. Very fresh and focused, this is an elegant medium-bodied wine that's only just beginning to display its abundant spicy and savory character. Compact and long, moderately dry finish. A cuvee from three GG sites. Unfiltered. From biodynamically grown grapes. Drink or hold.

#### SCHNAITMANN RIESLING WÜRTTEMBERG GÖTZENBERG GG 2021 Württemberg

Score 93

Very distinctive smoky nose with notes of quince, candied orange and fresh almond. Full-bodied, concentrated and compact, the finish crisp and mineral. Long structured finish that's deftly underlined by fine tannins. From biodynamically grown grapes. Drink or hold.

This expressive, barely medium-bodied Lemberger rosé marries bright nectarine fruit and smoky character to a citrusy freshness and a restrained spritz. #### SCHNAITMANN LEMBERGER WÜRTTEMBERG STEINWIEGE 2021 Württemberg

Score 92

Brimming with wild berries plus notes of licorice, pepper and soy sauce. Impressive depth and structure on the medium-bodied palate for an entry level wine, the savory and elderberry character neatly interlocking with the fine tannins that power the long velvety finish. From organically grown grapes. Vegan. Unfiltered. Drink or hold.

Crisp and substantial with plenty of flint. The citrusy character is not just zesty, there's also a touch of bitterness that reminds me of orange pith. Bold, long finish that's still very refreshing. Very limited production due to mildew losses. From biodynamically grown grapes. Vegan. Drink or hold.

Score 91

Here is a joyful and supple dry white that marries creaminess with white tree fruits and a discreet yellow apple freshness. Surprising structure and length, the harmony at the finish spot on. A blend based on 60% chardonnay with 35% pinot blanc and a few percent of skin-fermented pinot gris. From biodynamically grown grapes. Vinified completely used oak. Vegan. Drink now.

#### SCHNAITMANN SAUVIGNON BLANC BERGMANDEL TROCKEN 2022 Württemberg

Still very young on the nose, this already has an attractive balance of creaminess and mineral freshness on the palate. Quite weighty core of the medium- to full-bodied palate, then the well-crafted fine tannins come through at the finish. Delicate white currant and lemon pith aromas. From biodynamically grown grapes. Vinified completely in used oak. Vegan. Drink now.
